Lash is more in advice worth heeding in most all beauty matters except one. When it comes to eyelashes, there's no such thing as too-dark, too-long or too full. The only rule — and how fitting that it has a holiday ring — is the more, the merrier.

The beauty industry is all too happy to encourage our obsession. Mascaras that lengthen, thicken, curl and even promise the effect of fibers have been joined at the counter by growth encouragers, conditioning serums and hybrids such as MAC's new Prep + Prime Future Length Lash Serum. Indie label Hourglass Cosmetics recently introduced something called Film Noir Lash Lacquer, an "inky black top coat" that's meant to be worn over mascara and gives lashes a patent-leatherish gloss.

More lasting effects, in the form of semipermanent extensions, are as close as the nearest Lash Fairy or Lash Lounge. A newer option is LashDip, a salon-only process that its creators say is 30 times faster than regular mascara and, with precolored touch-ups, lasts up to six weeks. Or from New Year's Eve straight through to Valentine's Day.
